Bauchet Père & Fils



At the time of the 1999 harvest, our A.O.C. Champagne appellation vineyards covered 35 hectares, 12 of which lie within the Marne département at Grauves "Côte des Blancs" (where the Chardonnay grape truly flourishes) and Bisseuil "Montagne de Reims" (both of which have "Premier Cru" status) and 23 in the Aube département at Bragelone-Beauvoir, mostly in the vicinity of Les Riceys and Bligny.

This large area (by Champagne standards) makes us the leading "Producteur Récoltant Manipulant" (literally 'Grower Producer Manipulator') entity in the Champagne region.

In 1999, we harvested 435,000 kilos of grapes from these vineyards, representing the equivalent of 380,000 standard (75 cl) bottles.

This area is due to increase to 37 hectares in the near future.

In the Bisseuil area, the vineyards of the Marne département are mostly planted with Chardonnay vines (white grape) and in part with Pinot Noir vines. In Grauves, we grow only Chardonnay grapes and, in the Aube, almost exclusively Pinot Noir.

The average age of the vines is 15 years, taking annual partial replacement into consideration.

BAUCHET P. and F. Rosé

Made from subtle proportions of our best white wines (85%) and our Pinot Noir wine vinified as red (15%), and produced only in excellent years, our Brut Rosé boasts a finesse and elegance found only in the greatest of Champagne wines. It is available exclusively as Brut in standard 75 cl bottles and is packed in personalised 6-bottle cardboard boxes.
